<b>Rutherford B. Hayes</b> elected president	1. What was Hayes's position on civil service reform? What did he do to promote it? Supported reform; named independents to his cabinet; set up a commission to investigate customhouses; fired 3 top officials of the New York customhouse
<b>James A. Garfield</b> elected president	2. In the debate over civil service reform, did Garfield seem to favor the <b>Stalwarts</b> or the <b>reformers</b> ? The reformers
<b>Garfield assassinated</b> <b>Chester A. Arthur</b> assumes the presidency	3. What position did Arthur take on civil service reform, and what did he do to support it? Supported reform; urged Congress to pass a civil service law (the Pendleton Act)
<b>Pendleton Act passed</b>	4. What did the <b>Pendleton Act</b> do? Authorized a bipartisan civil service commission to make appointments based on merit rather than on spoils
<b>Grover Cleveland</b> elected president	5. What was Cleveland's position on tariffs, and what did he do to promote the position? Supported low tariffs; urged Congress to lower rates; ran for a second term on a low tariff platform
<b>Theodore Roosevelt</b> elected president	6. What was Roosevelt's position on tariffs, and what did he do to support that stand? Supported a high tariff; won passage of the McKinley Tariff Act, which raised tariffs to their highest level since 1846
<b>Cleveland</b> reelected president	7. What happened to tariffs during Cleveland's second presidency? They were lowered
<b>William McKinley</b> elected president	8. What happened to tariffs during McKinley's presidency? They were raised
